New Student Orientation



The arrival of new resident students over Labor Day Weekend marks the opening of New Student Orientation. Orientation Leaders and Assistants are stationed throughout campus to assist new students with the exhausting task of carrying their belongings to their rooms, while Resident Assistants complete the administrative details of room contracts and keys. Greek organizations play an important role as well -- moving students in, providing refreshments to the Orientation and Residence Life staffs, and greeting new students and their families. Orientation Week officially begins on Tuesday, with the now famous Orientation Introduction.





The orientation process can be a confusing one for new students -- hold cards, ID cards, meal cards, health holds, academic holds, financial holds... an orientee is quickly overwhelmed. Check-in begins in the Charlesgate Beige Room and takes the new student through each clearance, form, and credit evaluation. By the end of the week, students are registered and admitted into class. 4 Charlesgate East



Charlesgate and Fensgate sit on opposite sides of Beacon Street on the west end of the Emerson campus. Charlesgate is home to 400 undergraduate students, 11 of whom serve as resident assistants. Though its unique structure and history is part of its charm, residents have actively campaigned to improve some of the physical features of the building, which age and wear have caused to break down. This academic year, more administrative offices moved into Charlesgate, including Public Safety and the Alcohol and Other Drug Education Center.

Fensgate, with a capacity of 215 residents, including 6 RAs, serves the larger community through the Fensgate Dining Commons, which is an activity space as well as a dining room.

6 Arlington is one of the smaller residence halls on campus. As with all the residence halls, there are laundry facilities, a snack and soda machine and a desk sitter to collect the mail and screen visitors into the building. There are about twelve rooms on each floor consisting of singles, doubles and triples.

0 Marlborough is the other side of 6 Arlington. It has two classrooms and a deli style eatery which until this year was a cafeteria. A Pizza Hut resides in the deli, moved over from the other side of the hall which is now the faculty/staff dining room.

100 Beacon Street

100 Beacon is the smallest hall on campus, able to house about 82 residents consisting of graduate and non-traditional students. There is a computer center on the first floor which any student can use.

Besides the residents, there are a number of offices on the first five floors. Along with the Registrars and Student Accounts, there is the Financial Aid office as well as the Writing, Publishing and Literature Department. Several professors have their offices on these floors.

In the previous years, the basement of 100 Beacon was the Emerson College bookstore which has moved to the basement of 143 Beacon. The printshop now occupies the bookstore spot, neighboring the mailroom.



132/134 Beacon Street

132/134 Beacon is an interesting hall because of the way it's situated on the street. Half the hall faces Beacon Street and the other half faces Berkeley. When you enter the building, the front stairs lead up to the side that faces Beacon. There are doubles, singles and triples. The back stairs lead up to the other side which have doubles and singles. Residents share a common bathroom set between the rooms.

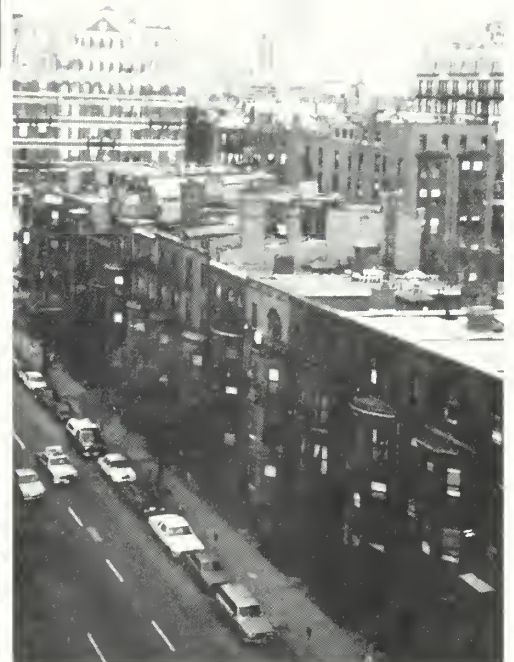

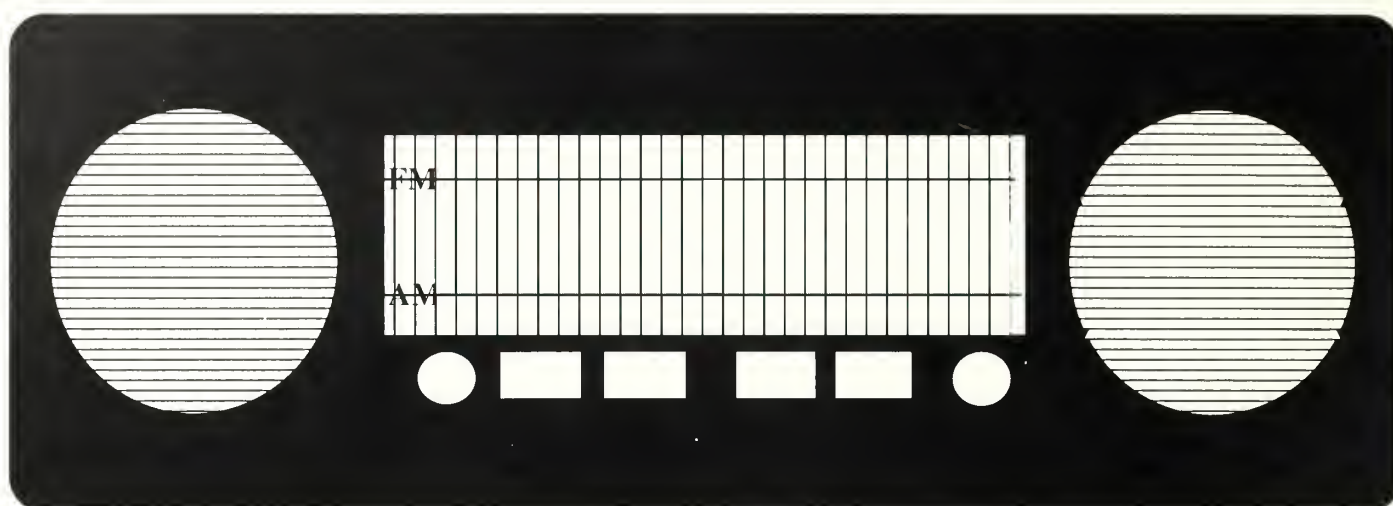

WERS 88.9 FM

This is New England's oldest non-commercial radio station reaching out to a potential audience of three million people with its eclectic blend of music, news and public affairs programming. The 4,000 watt station is entirely student operated and has been recognized nationally for its excellence. *BOSTON* magazine chose it as Boston's best radio station in 1989 and *DETAILS* magazine made the same choice in 1991. WERS raises its own funding through its annual live Music Week fundraiser, during which over 90 live musical performances are presented from the WERS studios. Auditions are held at the beginning of each term.

WECB 640 AM

WECB-AM is the carrier current broadcast and teaching facility of Emerson's Division of Mass Communication. It was the first college commercial radio station, broadcasting since March 1946. WECB serves Emerson dining and residence halls. It is a commercial station operating on money earned from advertising. All students are eligible to audition for DJ and other on-air positions at the beginning of each semester. No previous experience or license is required. Activities at WECB include sales, production, public affairs, music, announcing, news-reporting and sportscasting. Facilities include a master control, news studio, production room and record library.

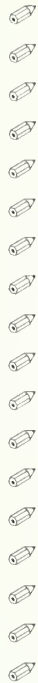

Be your own gypsy. Perhaps, be your own child, the one who needs so much attention.

and yet, unlikely as it may seem to other fortune-tellers you may know, I can still see this scent, still conjure it up with ease:

You open this child up like a Steinway grand, in awe, feeling small, each little cry striking you like a gong. And I'll always imagine it like this--this renaissance chiaroscuro, this music, this deliberateness, this patience. The poetry and you clear, frank brow. they invented the waterpik.

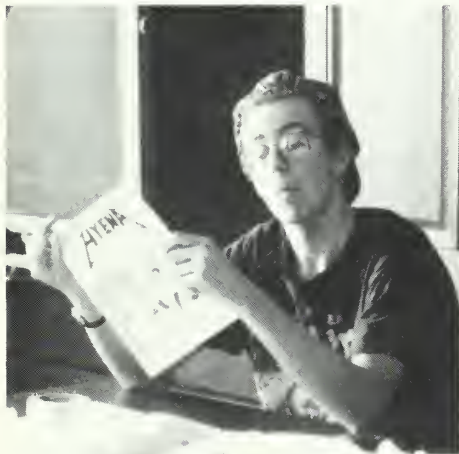

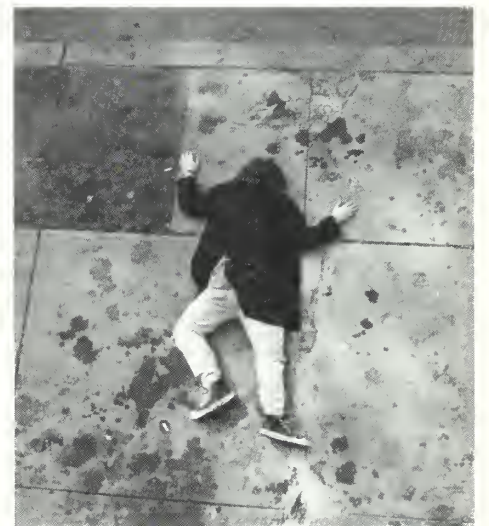

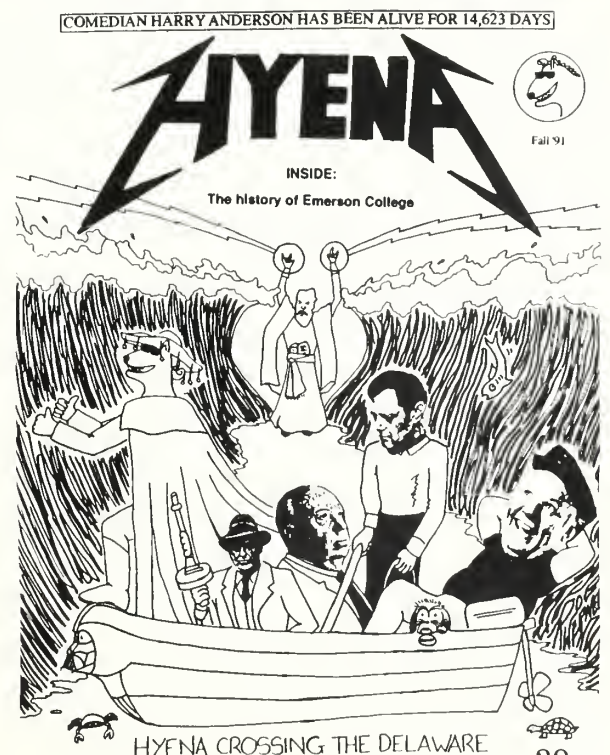
